Place: Tallinn, Estonia, Sokos Hotel Viru

The Baltic Sea Challenge and the CITYWATER project participated in the Linnade valdade päevad, the Estonian municipality days, on 13-14 February 2013. It is a yearly event for municipal managers, public authorities, experts, politicians and entrepreneurs.

Participating in the municipality days was very fruitful. The City of Helsinki Environment Centre had a stand at the event, which attracted tens of people that wanted to hear more about the state of the Baltic Sea, about the Baltic Sea Challenge network and about the recently started CITYWATER project.

During 13 February contacts were made with for example representatives of the Estonian Environment Information Centre (Keskkonnateabe Keskus), the Estonian National Youth Council (Eesti Noorteühenduste Liit), as well as the head of the international projects department at Tallinn City. During the day Baltic Challenge material, as well as CITYWATER factsheets were handed out. All materials were available at the stand also during the second day.

Present at the municipality days were CITYWATER representatives both from Tallinn City and from the City of Helsinki. Also, one of the Baltic Sea Challenge coordinators took part in the event.
